



## THE VISION

Greetings to you in the Name of all names,

My name is Pastor and Kohen, Theodore Meredith. Let me start with some basic information on my background. I live in Samoa, an island in the South Pacific. I have been in Christian ministry for more than 20 years, and I served as a pastor for ten years. I have started many Christian TV and radio stations in the Islands and have planted churches. By background, I am a business entrepreneur, and I have managed many successful businesses. About 12 years ago, I was called to be a Hebrew scholar and a Torah teacher, my ongoing occupation. I have authored 22 books.

More than ten years ago I received a vision from Heaven in line with the message of the Navi (Prophet) Yeshayahu (Isaiah) in Yeshayahu (Isaiah) 42:22-23;

*“22 But this is a people robbed and spoiled, they are all of them snared in holes, and they are hid in prison houses: they are for a prey, and none delivers, for a spoil, and none says, **Restore!** 23 Who among you will give ear to this? Who will hearken and hear for the time to come?”*

In this vision, I saw a Restoration Centre in Samoa where the presence and power of YHWH are tangible just as it was when the great King Solomon dedicated the first Temple in Yisra'el more than 2,700 years ago. This presence is called the Shekinah. I must confess I am not the only one in my country who have this revelation of a major move of Eloah (God) in Samoa that will touch the world.

In the last five years, this message has been returning to me in dreams and visions, and for years I set it aside because I was not then ready. I knew the Scripture clearly speaks of the return and restoration of the Torah (the Hebrew Scriptures), the Tabernacle of David, and the Kohanim (The Priesthood) of Solomon's time.

*“In that day I will raise up the Sukkah of Dawid (the Tabernacle of David) that has fallen, and close up the breaches of it; and I will raise up its ruins, and I will rebuild it as in the days of old:”* Ahmos (Amos) 9:11. See also Maaseh Shlichim (Acts) 15:16.

*“And in rachamim (mercy) shall the kesay (throne) be established: and He shall sit upon it in emet (truth) in the Sukkah of Dawid (the Tabernacle of David), judging, and seeking mishpat (justice), and bringing tzedakah (righteousness) speedily”* Yeshayahu (Isaiah) 16:5.

I have been studying Hebrew, Temple, and Priestly protocols, customs, and prayers for more than seven years. The fruits of this labor enabled me to publish more than seven books on the subjects. I knew the time was approaching where I have to implement this knowledge, but there were pertinent questions I needed to answer, and the answers came piece by piece through the years. How and where is this center going to be established was my main concern? The answer one of heaven's best-kept secrets!

Many great revivals have come and gone in the Church (Kahal); the last was in Pensacola, Florida. The Brownsville Revival (also known as the Pensacola Outpouring) was a widely reported Christian

revival within the Pentecostal movement that began on Father's Day June 18, 1995, at Brownsville Assembly of God in Pensacola, Florida.

Characteristics of the Brownsville Revival movement, as with other Christian religious revivals, included acts of repentance by parishioners and a call to holiness, inspired by the manifestation of the Ruah Ha Kodesh (the Holy Spirit). Some of the occurrences in this revival fit the description of moments of religious ecstasy. More than four million people are reported to have attended the revival meetings from its beginnings in 1995 to around 2000. The Toronto Blessings, to name another revival, also impacted millions of people.

In 2019, YHWH spoke to me again; this time, He reminded me of what He told me more than ten years ago and let me know I was ready and to stop hiding the prophecy. The message was simple and clear; "Build Me a building (a Centre) where He will bring the Shekinah back on Earth." A place where Eloah would manifest His glory, presence, and power as He did in the First Assembly of Israel. A home where the Ark of the Covenant and its furnishing will be located.

Eloah directed me to Samoa although I questioned this location and He showed me the exact place where the Centre will be built but why Samoa? Samoa, as He explained to me, is only a starting place of what Eloah plans to do across the globe climaxing in Yerushalem. Samoa is literally at the ends of the Earth, and from here, YHWH will return the Shekinah to Yerushalem. This was Yeshua prophecy in Markus (Mark) 10:16 that the Gospel (the message of the Kingdom) will go to the ends of the Earth, then the end shall begin.

The location of the Centre will be two properties in the middle of the City of Apia directly opposite two Government buildings that are iconic to our small City. There are two private properties that their owners are interested in selling at the right price. The location is within walking distance to many hotels and accommodations in Apia, which will be essential to the revival. The place is simply perfect.

Immediately I set out to draw a preliminary plan of the layout of the Centre, its location, and the budget. See the attached Excel sheet. All in all, it will cost 114 M USD, only a fraction of what this restoration will bring for the people of Samoa and the world, but where would the money come from? Eloah said a donor, "His donor," would fund His project because this person awaits this message. Meaning Eloah's donor will know this is why Eloah prospered and blessed them. I don't discount the fact that it could well be a woman or an organization.

Samoa is by no means a popular international and tourist destination. Indeed the hotel industry in Samoa has been struggling for years. Our economy is small, with a 2 billion GDP per year and our population a mere 200,000 people. However, there is one thing that sets Samoa apart from most nations in the world. It is constitutionally a Christian country and has a written accord with the Eloah of Israel, signed by our Head of State in 2019.

About 95 percent of Samoans are Christians, and most attend a Church regularly. Samoa has strong Bible teaching institutions and a worldwide missionary movement. The most esteemed position in Samoan society is to become a minister of the Church; thousands apply each year. We are a serving people in heart and spirit.

Among other factors why Samoa is chosen are a strong priestly cast, a strong family and community network, and an ancient way of life called the Faa-Samoa that mirrors the tribal history of Yisra'el. Many of our customs and tradition are similar to the Bible. The revival would draw upon many of these factors to maintain its growth and establish its dominion.

Also, Samoa is a beautiful country and has much to offer visitors and pilgrims with a mild and warm climate all year around. Most of the staff that will be employed at the Centre will be found in Samoa and from our neighboring islands, although many specialists will come from distant countries.

The Centre will employ more than 750 people, and we can afford this because of the low wage factor in Samoa. We also anticipate using more than 200 local volunteer staff. Later as the Centre flourishes, we will export and support missionaries and churches worldwide.

The revival will bring into Samoa more than seven million visitors a year and many dignities and the business elite of the world. The Centre will become Samoa's major foreign revenue source bringing into Samoa more than 7 billion a year in foreign currencies much of it in donations and gifts to the Centre.

Indeed where ever Eloah's presence is manifested, His financial blessing and prosperity go hand in hand (Schmuel Bet (2 Samuel) 6:11). It is this reason why I also believe it is imperative we start another local bank in Samoa, "YHWH bank," to manage these sources and assets instead of letting Eloah's money be managed by other banks. Part of the money we will invest back into the country and create other centers in the world calumniating at the main Center in Yerushalem in 2027.

The planned budget includes a banking development costing 7M USD. The idea of the Centre is that it becomes financially self-sufficient, requiring no further investment after the initial budget. The Centre has a commercial section where food and other necessities will be provided for the thousands of people that will visit the Centre daily. A special store will be needed to distribute sacred items like tallits, anointing oils, shofars, mezuzahs, etc. that are part of the restoration.

How will this revival/restoration work? At the top of the main building, "the WildFire Centre" will be the Ark auditorium where the Tabernacle of David will be reconstructed according to the model of the Tabernacle. A residing priesthood under the order of *Melchizedek* will oversee and officiate in the Tabernacle. National and International musicians, singers, and dancers will perform daily in the services. Local churches will officiate, and their worship teams will perform weekly in the Tabernacle.

About 800-1000 people will be able to attend their 3-4 daily services six times a week. These services will be televised worldwide on major Christian networks that cover the globe as well as on the internet. Our brand and style of music and dance will be unique and distributed worldwide from the Centre.

The Prayer Center will open 24/7 days a week, and there will be weekly seminars to enhance prayer and the doing of good deeds. Our Conference Center will host on a weekly basis guest speakers from around the globe that will bring teachings for Eloah's people, and their messages will be televised globally.

Dignitaries and VIPs that will visit the Centre will be afforded the best security service and provided with special seating. Visiting Government officials, pastors, and ministers will be distinguished with unique seating. The auditorium will accommodate all people and types.

It is essential to state that the WildFire Centre is not a Church, a denomination, or a religion. It will not be registered. It is a spiritual movement that has no boundaries, established theologies, and a membership role. It is based on the Hebrew Scriptures and will follow the instructions of the Word of Eloah. We are open to all faiths, and we will not reject any religion that wished to bring homage to the Elohim of Yisra'el.

The goals of this restoration are to restore the Tabernacle of David, reactivate the Priesthood, revive the Hebrew language and the practice of Hebrew traditions and customs, teach the whole counsel of

the Word of Eloah, awaken the family of Yisra'el, refresh Eloah's people and strengthen the father and the family.

Among our other vital goals will be the care and love of Eloah's creation – Nature and the creation of environmental developments that will protect our islands from pollution and other dangers. The education of Science and the Universe will be part of our movement.

The project and operation will be managed by NOMANSZONE, a non-profit organization. See [nomnazone.org](http://nomnazone.org). I will oversee the project and manage it through its various construction phases. There will be many specialized people who will join me in this vision. These people are Church ministers, Jewish experts, and professional people. It will take about 6-8 months to prepare the core and body of people needed to work and operate this Centre. Everything will be professionally fulfilled and completed according to Eloah's righteous standard. The budget I have determined assures the only the best will be done.

As the donor, you will have a permanent place on the board of NOMANSZONE and a place of residence in the Centre and not to mention your place in His Kingdom and the glory to come.
